## Recyclable Plastic Products Collection to Begin

Recyclable plastic products will be collected in all Shinagawa City communities from April 1 onward.

## Plastic products we had been disposing of as combustible waste are now collected as recyclable plastic

#### How do you dispose of recyclable plastic products?

Put all plastic items (plastic containers, wrapping and products) together in one bag, and take the bag to your designated disposal location (the same location as before) on the designated collection day.

Note: PET bottles will continue to be collected separately as before.



Even items without the identifying "Pla-mark" can be disposed of as recyclable plastic products. For more information, please visit the Shinagawa City website.

#### Notice regarding Dog Registration and Periodic Group Rabies Vaccination

Dogs ninety-one days old or older are required by law to be registered once in their lifetime, and to get a rabies shot once a year.

#### Registration

If you purchase a dog at a pet shop or from a breeder or take ownership of a microchipped dog, you must register or renew your pet's microchipped information. Please register the new owner's information and complete the designated procedures on the Ministry of the Environment database (https://reg.mc.env.go.jp) based on the registration certificate you received with your dog. Other issues:

- Please complete the designated procedures in the Ministry of the Environment database if you move to another location or if your dog dies
- It is strongly recommended to implant a microchip in dogs you already own
- If your dog is not yet microchipped, you must complete registration procedures at the Shinagawa City Office service counter (registration fee: ¥3,000)
- If your dog is already registered in the Ministry of the Environment database and a problem arises, please contact the Microchip Information Registration Service Counter (Tel: 03-6384-5320).

#### Periodic Group Rabies Vaccination

According to the Rabies Prevention Act, dog owners must have their pets vaccinated annually to prevent rabies. Periodic group vaccinations will be conducted at fifteen designated veterinary hospitals in Shinagawa City.

#### Notes:

- 1. Since the hours of these locations vary, please check the website or bulletins of the veterinary hospital you plan to use.
- 2. If you cannot bring your pet in for this vaccination within the designated period, please do so at a veterinary hospital and complete the application procedures to receive a vaccination completion slip at the Shinagawa City electronic application service or one of the following places—the Public Hygiene Section (Hon Chosha 7F), Shinagawa or Ebara Health Service Center—or at your local community center no later than Sunday, June 30.

**Eligibility:** Dogs ninety-one days old or older registered in Shinagawa City **Fee:** ¥3,750 (vaccination fee/vaccination tag issuance fee)

#### Notes:

1. If you have your dog vaccinated on a day outside of the designated period, the fees may be different.

2. A separate initial fee may be charged.
